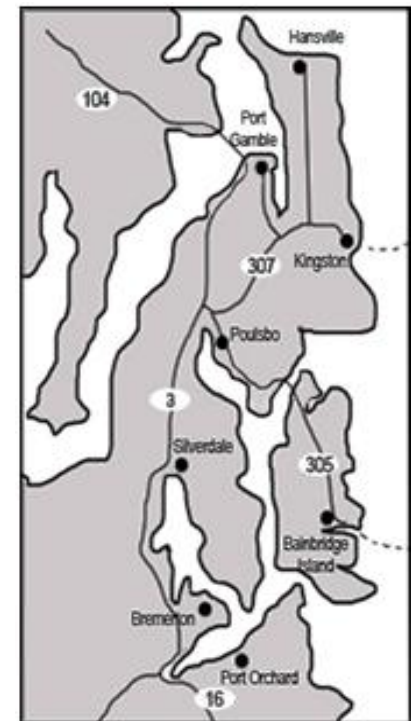

START/FINISH: Harrison Silverdale Health Care Campus
1800 Myhre Rd. Silverdale

TIME: Daily - Dawn to Dusk

DIRECTIONS: 1800 NW Myhre Rd. I-5 (Tacoma) exit 132, (HWY 16) to Bremerton. Follow Hwy 16 to junction with Hwy 3. Follow Hwy 3 north past Bremerton to Silverdale. Take exit 45B (Hwy 303) East Bremerton. Follow Hwy 303 to Ridgetop Blvd. (first exit). Take the Ridgetop exit. At the end of the exit ramp turn right and right again to Harrison Silverdale Healthcare Campus. Follow signs for "Emergency Walk-In."

Walk Box: *wooden filing cabinet within the entry vestibule.*

TIME: Daily - Dawn to Dusk

DIRECTIONS From SR3 take Newberry Hill Road Exit. Turn WEST on Newberry Hill Rd and go 3.3 miles to start box location. Ask for walk box at counter. **It will be necessary to drive 0.9 miles to trailhead to start this walk.** Restrooms at start box location only.

ROUTE: Walk along woodland trails past wetlands and through forests and meadows. Bicycles & horses allowed on trail; yield to horses on trail.

HANSVILLE

(2 WALKS)

START/FINISH: Hansgrill Hansville Grocery & Provisions Company, 7542 Twin Spits Rd, Hansville

TIME: 7:30a.m.-7:30 p.m. daily. Closed major holidays

DIRECTIONS: From the Kingston-Edmonds Ferry stay on SR104 to the first stop light (about 1.7 miles). Turn RIGHT on HANSVILLE Road. The Hansgrill Hansville Grocery & Provisions Company is on the right as the road begins to curve to the left in town. From the west: take SR 104 as if you are going to the Kingston-Edmonds Ferry and turn LEFT on HANSVILLE Road. From the south: on SR3, take the Poulsbo exit and at the third stoplight turn LEFT onto SR307 (Bond Road). SR 307 merges with SR104. Continue as above from the west. **Walk Box:** *Left by door.*

The 11KM route follows country roads all the way out to historic Point No Point Lighthouse, then follows "Sid Knutson" trail returning to the Greenway and Buck Lake. The 21KM route follows the "Sid Knutson" trail walking from Puget Sound to Hood Canal on roadway shoulders and primitive trails. Restrooms on the route.
