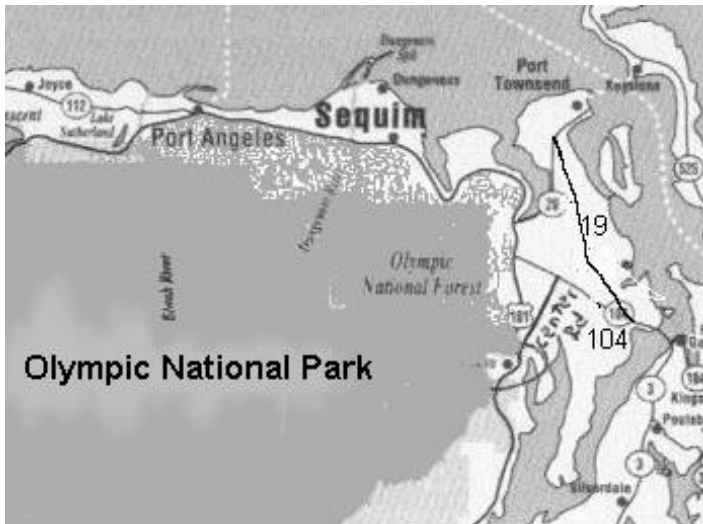

REMOTE START:Registration is on line after mail-in of fees to Todd Oberlander, 293 Kingfisher Pl, Port Hadlock, WA 98339. Directions will be e-mailed/mailed after receipt of fees.

ROUTE: Walk on city streets and parks through residential areas and retrace the locations made famous by Stephenie Meyer in her “Twilight Saga” books and movies: the Police Station, Forks High School and Forks Hospital. Pets are permitted; owners are responsible for leash and clean-up laws.

NORDLAND - FORT FLAGLER

START/FINISH: Nordland General Store,

TIMES: Mon-Fri: 7 am - 7 pm; Sat: 8 am - 7 pm; Sun: 9 am - 6 pm. Closed Thanksgiving and Christmas

DIRECTIONS. From Hood Canal Bridge: Follow SR104 to Port Townsend exit (SR19). Follow SR19 north to Chimacum (4-way stop). RIGHT to Port Hadlock to next 4-way stop. RIGHT and take second LEFT to Indian Island/Nordland. Follow this highway (SR116) to Fort Flagler. Follow Volksmarch signs to start/finish.

From Keystone-Port Townsend Ferry: LEFT on Water St for 5 miles. Keep to LEFT on SR19 and drive 3.4 miles to Port Hadlock and turn LEFT on SR116. Continue as above.

NOTE: YOU MUST DRIVE FROM THE STORE TO FORT FLAGLER TO BEGIN WALKING.

ROUTE: This walk explores the fascinating history and natural beauty of Marrowstone Island and Fort Flagler. See the beautiful views, waterfront camp ground and many batteries to explore.

Wild Birds is about five miles past Discovery Bay, on the right at MP 276. There is ample parking, but park away from the front of the store. From the west, Wild Birds is about 10 miles east of Sequim on US 101. You will see the Gardiner Community Center on your left just before coming to Wild Birds on the left.

ROUTE: See the Trolls carved into the buildings and fence posts of Troll Haven!!! You may see the mountains on a clear day. You will pass a boat ramp and a beautiful fire house.

DIRECTIONS: Drive though Port Angeles on Hwy 101 West, turn LEFT on Lincoln Street; continue straight on Lincoln past several stop lights and turn RIGHT on Lauridsen Boulevard at the stop light staying on 101 West . Go about a mile. Just before the Shell Station is the Fairmount Restaurant on the right. The Walk Box is to the right, inside the door.

ROUTE: This trail offers a gentle stroll along Lake Crescent's north shore. Mostly following the old abandoned railroad grade, it skirts two tunnels, which are dangerous to enter. There are beautiful views of Lake Crescent and a host of other landmarks. Parts of the trail are rocky and sometimes a bit muddy - baby joggers can be used with difficulty; wheelchairs not recommended. No pets. Restrooms at the trailhead & Log Cabin Resort.

ROUTE: Along this trail the forest mixes the elements of the rainforests to the west with plants of the rainshadow to the east. As the trail reaches the spectacular Sol Duc Falls the route turns downstream following the east bank back to the starting point. Not suitable for wheelchairs, strollers or baby joggers. NO PETS. Restrooms along the route.

Subway is on the left across from the ferry entrance at the stop light. Park your car in the lot on the right or on the street, after passing the ferry entrance. Walk across to Subway to register. Please no parking in the limited Subway lot. Restrooms available. Ask for the walk box.

Walk along the nature/hiking trails throughout this heavily wooded park, with its rich military history dating from pioneer days. Baby joggers possible, wheelchairs not recommended on both the 5 & 10 Km walks
